Have pheromones peaked your curiosity and you're willing to test them away, but are confused and skeptical over the overwhelming number of companies as well as websites selling pheromones and the wild claims they will make?

Have been using pheromones for several years and while I've never seen the wild results that some of these products promise, I have had some pretty good results with some products and have seen solid and simpler results.



There are hundreds, if not thousands of websites selling products, offering product reviews and links to suppliers. I can tell you from first hand experience and from information shared by others that the vast majority of these companies, web sites and reviews are scams. If you find a [pheromone review](#) website that gives a 5 star rating to a product and offers a link to their website, hover your mouse over the link and search in the position bar in the bottom of the browser, if the link doesn't go directly to the particular firms website it is almost certainly linking through an affiliate marketing program, as well as the owner of the pheromone review site is paid a commission for each and every customer they refer.

A person don't see the position bar at the bottom of your screen, you are able to enable it in Internet Explorer or FireFox by clicking on the "View" menu at the very top of your browser and checking next to the Status Bar.

- So, how can you discover legitimate products that will work and enable you to achieve your desired goals?
- Your best bet is to join a couple of forums, ask questions and read what others have to say.
- And once again there are a number of forums and most of them are owned by pheromone companies.
- Some of these forums are very energetic, while others tend to be almost dormant.
- Some let you talk about any pheromone product, while others will only let you talk about products they sell.
- Some will let you talk about a couple of other companies or products, while blacklisting others.
- And some forums heavily censor fellow member postings, while others may not.
- So, right now we have to look for a reputable forum!
- One of the better ways to calculate the particular trustworthiness of a pheromone forum is actually taking a look at their members:

Do they have a dynamic membership, or are the vast majority of postings coming from one or two people?

- Are the original and/or long term members still around and lively in the forum?
- Or even, where did they're going and also why did they leave?

Does the forum have lots of threads and also postings, almost all created within a very short time frame?

Do they have a ton of sign ups signing upward and making simply a couple of posts, after that disappearing?

And just like importantly, do the administrators seem helpful and informative, or carry out they appear negative and judgmental?

Once again, I can tell you from experience that some of the largest and most active forums on the net are now nothing more than marketing tools and hoopla to sell their own products and they are not truly interested in providing accurate and helpful information to people seeking information on products other than their own.

By now your head is probably spinning and you're about ready to give up, right? Don't! Pheromones do work and there are legitimate products out there. You just have to look around a bit, seek information, and find the right companies and products to buy. These are out there, and pheromones do work!

There are only a couple of forums on the net that are not affiliated with any company or product. These forums aren't large in size and don't have thousands of members that were bought through marketing efforts, but exist solely for pheromone enthusiasts to talk with each other and share information.
